Directions to House 6

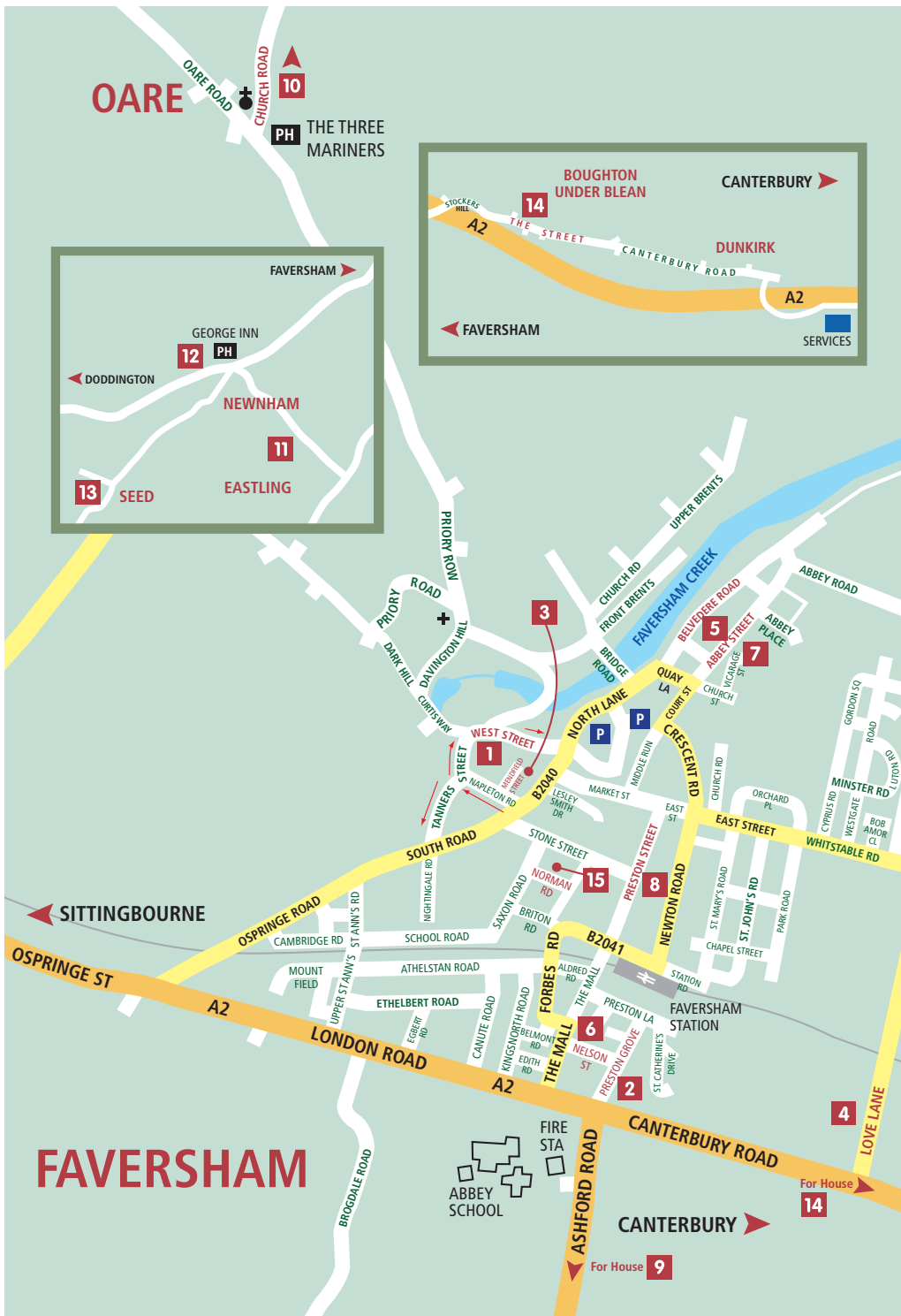
From A2 - Bishopsbourne - past church on right - up Station Hill on to Crow's Camp Road - 200 yards bear left at junction on bend - 200 yards drive on the right. Ample parking, disabled access.

Directions to House 7

From the A2 Dover bound take the exit for Barham. At the junction turn right under the bridge and turn left towards Barham and Elham. Continue through Barham to the hill with the old Methodist church on the right. Just past it, is the house on the right.

Directions to House 8

Take A28 Canterbury towards Ashford. Turn right into Howfield Lane (at Brownhills), 1½ miles up the hill New House is second on right after Nightingale Close.



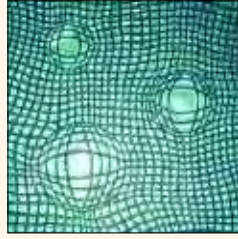
